Update:

- We have received positive feedback from many sources congratulating the Committee on the success of the Post Graduate Conference.
- So far, our chapter has sold \$1326.00 worth of T-shirts. We will continue to sell T-shirts at the upcoming picnic and through the fall semester.
- The annual faculty/student picnic will be held on Monday, August 26, 2002; classes begin the following Wednesday. The possibility of providing beer was discussed. It is unlawful to serve alcoholic beverages at a public park in Lexington; therefore, a venue other than Woodland Park may be investigated if we would like to serve beer.
- The chapter should have sufficient funds to cover the cost of the chicken to be served at the picnic.
